This document is about the National Disability Insurance Scheme. It is also called the NDIS and NDIS funding.



Funding is the money you get from the NDIS to pay for things you need and want to do.



We want to update you on changes to this funding and prices for your supports.



The National Disability Insurance Agency (also called the NDIA) manages the NDIS.



The NDIA decides the price for disability services. Every year on 1 July the NDIA updates these prices.



The NDIA tells service providers like Independent Disability Services what the new prices are.



Independent Disability Services then updates their prices to match the NDIA.



The NDIA makes sure your NDIS Plan funding also changes to match the new prices.



This means if prices change, your funding also changes by the same amount.



Your supports will remain the same. You do not have to do anything more.
